

I have outlined where I see possible connections between the Citizens League 2006 Medical Facilities report: and the work of the Governor's Health Care Transformation Task Force. The connections are mainly based on two areas of Citizens League 2006 work:

- **Information**
- **Governance**

When you think of those two words, it is much easier to look at the Citizens League 2006 report and the latest draft of the work of the Governor's Health Care Transformation Task Force. The Task Force is a much more comprehensive approach, but there are many key connections based on information and governance.

There are also many possible connections between the Citizens League 1987 report: **Start Right with "Right Start" (A Health Plan for Minnesota's Uninsured)** and the Transformation Task Force. A more thorough analysis of that connection has not been done (any volunteers?). The 1987 report intersects with the Task Force and that is based on two other words:

- **Access**
- **Insurance**
